

Lawrence Marr Sr. family information from Northampton County, Pennsylvania, tax, exoneration, and assessment lists

Men were included on the tax lists once they reached the age of 21. So the tax lists, assuming they are accurate, can be used to determine when a man turned 21.

All entries are Mount Bethel unless otherwise noted.
